NOTE: All microphones models are by reference and sample only - we accept any other brand microphones.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT CHEAP microphones (i.e BEHRINGER, IMG, STAGE LINE, etc.).

POSSIBILITY OF RECORDING FROM THE MIXERS OUTS WOULD BE GREAT (pre-fader, pre-EQ even better!)



BAND WILL SUPPLY: instruments (2 guitars and pedal effects, bass guitar + pedal effects, drum cymbals+snare+double pedal+sticks+local mixer for in ear monitoring.)

THE VENUE WILL SUPPLY: guitar and bass amps drum throne, 1 DI box, 12 microphones (see table above), 5 monitors with 5 individual busses, mixer to support 12 inputs minimum. 4 power cords each with 4 sockets minimum.

SOUND CHECK:


We require a minimum 60-minute sound check, scheduled at least two hours prior to opening the house. The sound system's full set-up, patching, line-checking, troubleshooting, and system EQ-ing must be complete prior to the scheduled sound check. All personnel responsible for audio must be present for the entire duration of the sound check. During the sound check, show organizer will ensure the house is clear of everyone except those people directly involved in the sound check or other approved RESTLESS's guests. Thank you!!!:D

SCENE:

Minimum scene size 5 meters wide 4 meters deep and minimum 0,4 meters high from the ground. Ceiling height shall be no less than 2,5 meters from stage floor. Flat surface, all cables secured and fixed – no loose ends. Percussion platform minimum size is 2x2m, minimum 0,2m high from the stage floor. The outdoor concert scene should be fully secured primarily from moisture and wind, sheltered from the back and sides, as well as fully covered. Entrance for band hidden from the audience if possible. Plexiglas acoustic screen for drums if possible – but highly recommended for small venues (24inch bass drum).

STAGE PLAN (bass player can also be located on the other side of drummer, no problem 6):



POWER ON STAGE:

We require a stable voltage 230-240V, protected against voltage drops. Ground on all outlets.

LIGHTNING:

Lightning can be discussed during the sound check but in general we request a good concert lighting capable of dimming: usually a general color stage wash with an overhead and "front of house" spot light if possible. A follow spot would be nice if available, and would work very nicely with some "color" added - but this is not required. A Lighting board operator should be there to make sure the lighting focus suffices and to operate during the entire show and sound check. Please do NOT use fog - or at very minimum level but only if agreed with us before the show. Please do NOT use stroboscope effects! Thank you!!!

WARDROBE:

Locked, with mirror, 6 seats minimum, one bed, table. With min. 12 x 0,5l bottles of still and 12 of sparkling water & snacks.

OTHER:

Insurance for the show safety (civil responsibility) – secured by show organizer.
